Fellows will register for a postgraduate research degree (preferably at Doctoral level) and will assist in teaching in the relevant Department. The duration of the fellowship will normally be two or (at most) three years. Fellows will receive a scholarship and fees remission. Candidates should have a high level of academic achievement (primary degree 2:1 or better, MA or M.Ed).

Michael Jordan Fellowships in Education:

Candidates should have an excellent teaching record, expertise in an area of the primary school curriculum, and research interest in any area of Education Studies.

The successful applicants will meet with the eligibility requirements of Research/ Doctoral students at St Patrick's College, and will be required to complete the standard application process for Research degree students.
