Geography Department – Teaching Fellowship Fixed Term Ten Month Contract

Teaching Fellow

Applications are invited for a teaching fellowship in the **Geography Department**, St. Patrick's College Drumcondra for the academic year 2011-2012.

Eligibility

Doctoral students or post-doctoral candidates with some lecturing experience are eligible to apply.

Duties and Responsibilities

The successful applicant will undertake circa 6 hours per week of undergraduate level teaching. This will involve giving a lecture course to be agreed in semester two of the academic year 2011-12, acting as a lecturer/demonstrator in practical classes, contributing to team-taught courses as appropriate, leading tutorials, seminars and fieldtrips. In addition, the successful applicant will engage, as required, in setting and marking course work, setting and marking examinations, and be available for student consultation. The teaching fellow will be available for the equivalent of at least 2 ½ days per week on campus.

Award Period

It is anticipated that this Fellowship will commence on **1st October 2011**, and will be of ten months duration

Value

The value of the Teaching Fellowship will be: €20,000 (doctoral students): €22,000 (post-doctoral).
