Teaching Fellowship

Applications are invited for a teaching fellowship in the **History Department**, St. Patrick's College Drumcondra during the academic year 2011-12.

Eligibility

Doctoral students or post-doctoral candidates, preferably with some lecturing experience are eligible to apply.

Duties and Responsibilities

The successful applicant will undertake lecturing and tutoring at undergraduate level. S/he will deliver two courses of lectures to be agreed, and a number of tutorials. The courses can be on any theme in the Early Modern or Modern time period, and on a subject or theme in European or world history. In addition, the successful applicant will participate in departmental meetings, and engage, as required, in setting and marking course work, setting and marking examinations, and be available for student consultation.

Award Period

It is anticipated that this Fellowship will be of ten months duration commencing in November 2011.

Value

The value of the Fellowship is €20-22,000 (depending on qualification).

Applications procedure

Applications should be made by submitting a c.v., the names of two referees, a statement (1 page) as to why the candidate would like to be considered for the fellowship, and a brief outline of the courses they propose to teach, to
