Applications are invited for a teaching fellowship in the **Education Department**, St Patrick's College Drumcondra for the academic year 2011-2012

Eligibility

Doctoral students or post-doctoral candidates with some teaching experience are eligible to apply.

Duties and Responsibilities

The successful applicant will undertake 6-8 hours per week of undergraduate level teaching. This will involve contributing to team-taught courses in Philosophy of Education and in Human Development as appropriate, leading tutorials and seminars, setting and marking course work, setting and marking examinations, supervision of undergraduate theses and being available for student consultation. The successful applicant will attend meetings of the Human Development team as requested. S/he will attend meetings of the disciplines in Education and of the philosophy team. The teaching fellow will be available for the equivalent of at least 2 days per week on campus.

Award Period

It is anticipated that the Fellowship will commence end of September 2011 and will continue until the end of June 2012.

Value

The value of the Teaching Fellowship will be a stipend of €22,000 (post-doctoral) and €20,000 (doctoral students).
